

Important points to remember about making a payment at a hospital:

- Be sure to bring your Japanese health insurance card (National Health Insurance card, etc.) if you have one.

- Be sure to bring your travel insurance card or policy if you have travel insurance.
Be sure to bring Japanese yen with you, as some medical institutions are not able to process cashless payments.

- Be sure to bring Japanese yen with you, as some hospitals accept credit card payments, but some do not. Foreign currencies are usually not accepted for payment.

- Some hospitals require a security deposit before they will admit a patient.
